



70TH Annual Highway Geology Symposium

Guest Tour

This year's tour will travel through the city of Portland where guests will discover what makes this city so unique. Stops include the view point at the historic Pittock Mansion; the International Rose Test Garden; and a drive through Portland's most interesting east side neighborhoods including: the Pearl District, Portland's Waterfront, and Mt. Tabor Park.

Pittock Mansion has one of the best views in town. Nestled high in the West Hills, Pittock Mansion's viewpoint overlooks Portland's skyline from 1,000 feet up. On a clear day, enjoy vistas of five Cascade Mountains: Mount Hood, Mount St. Helens, Mount Adams, Mount Rainier, and Mount Jefferson.

The International Rose Test Garden is a rose garden in Washington Park in Portland, Oregon, United States. There are over 10,000 rose bushes of approximately 650 varieties. The roses bloom from April through October.

The trip will conclude with lunch at Laurelwood Brew Pub, a local craft brewery, and will include a short tour and beer sampling with your meal. Wine and spirits will also be available for purchase.
